ENEC 201, Introduction to Environment and Society: Human-environment interactions are examined through analytical methods from the social sciences, humanities, and sciences. ENEC satisfies Social Science (SS) and Global Issues (GL) general education requirements. Three lecture hours and one recitation hour a week.

In the Language Across Curriculum (LAC) Spanish Recitation for ENEC 201, we will discuss the main course themes in Spanish from a global perspective, with added emphasis on how they present themselves in the Spanish-speaking world. This section is an opportunity to use Spanish in a realistic conversational environment.
